New Business

Choir Director report

- The vote to continue the conversation regarding uniforms: Kathleen Stewart motioned and Nellie Spacek seconded the motion.

- Again, a uniformed program would help promote across the music department.
- MIM uniforms are coming but it is a very slow process. It's a mess.
- Emily is pushing for some money back.
